



SENIOR CARE OPTIONS

Senior Care Options (SCO) is a program through MassHealth that provides complete health care coverage for eligible older adults. SCO combines MassHealth and Medicare benefits with personalized case management to help members remain safe, healthy, and independent in the community.

GSSSI partners with several SCO health plans to deliver care management services, ensuring each member gets the right supports at the right time.

Senior Care Options plans makes it easier to get the care and support you need as you age. With one plan, you can receive your medical, prescription, dental, vision, and behavioral health benefits, plus in-home and community services. Our Geriatric Support Services Coordinators (GSSC) will work with your doctors and health plan to coordinate your care, connect you to resources, and help you stay safe and independent at home, all at no extra out-of-pocket cost.

Eligibility & Cost

To join a Senior Care Options plan, you must be 65 or older, live in the participating plan's service area, and be enrolled in both MassHealth Standard and Medicare. Individuals with an end-stage renal disease (ESRD) diagnosis are not eligible. Enrollment is open to new members year-round, and GSSSI can help you explore your options and direct you to the plan that best meets your needs.

How It Works

To apply and join a Senior Care Options (SCO) plan, potential members must call the plan directly or contact MassHealth at 1-800-841-2900. Once enrolled, GSSSI partners with your SCO health plan to provide case management services, helping you coordinate care and connect with the supports you need.
